**Mission Trip destination:**

Cheriton Baptist Church, Cheriton Virginia.

MBC Youth are headed to the eastern shore of Virginia to host the Cheriton Baptist Church Splash Camp in July!

Cheriton is located about ten miles from Cape Charles.

The youth and leaders will be responsible for providing a Vacation Bible School like experience with a Bible lesson, crafts, outdoor games, a field trip, and even some swim time at the YMCA.

The Splash Camp at Cheriton is part of the Cape Charles Baptist Church ministry, and is supervised by the same staff as is Splash Camp at Cape Charles.

**Who is eligible to attend:**

Youth in middle school and high school, college students, and adults of all ages. Youth must have completed the 6<sup>th</sup> grade in order to participate.

## **Registration deadline**

## **Housing**

Housing is provided by Cape Charles Baptist Church, either in the church facilities used in prior years, or in the Methodist church building across the street.

At either location, expect multiple people in each room.

Showers available at both locations.

## **Transportation**

The church bus will provide transportation for those who need it. The bus will depart from the church following lunch on Sunday, July 20<sup>th</sup>.

## **Meals:**

Meals are provided during the week at the church.

## **Return date and time:**

Friday, July 25<sup>th</sup> - Arrival at church approximately 8:30pm.

## **Job description:**

Lead Splash Camp Monday through Friday from 8:00 – 5:00. Splash Camp is a daycare ministry for children K – 6. Daily activities include VBS-style program in the mornings, plus afternoon outings for sailing, YMCA and some community missional involvement.

Possible migrant ministry support on Wednesday night ... providing supper and supporting the worship service.

## **Dress Code**

- finger-length tip shorts, wide strapped shirts (no muscle shirts, no spaghetti tank tops, etc.)
- no t-shirts with profane language or sexual innuendo, nor advertising alcohol, drugs, or other immoral behavior
- one piece bathing suits for females (no mid-drifts may show),
- fingertip length bathing suit bottoms for males (no speedos).

## **Packing List:**

- Clothes for five days ... there are no laundry facilities.
- Twin Sized Air Mattress and pump (Please nothing bigger than a twin we do not have room)
- Twin-sized sheets and blankets
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Deodorant, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, washcloth, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb/hairbrush, shower shoes, razor, lotion, shower caddy.
- bath and beach towel
- Summer clothing (t-shirts, shorts, etc., see Dress Code below)
- Tennis shoes, sandals or flip-flops
- Appropriate Pajamas
- Bathing suit cover-up and bathing suit (See Dress Code below)
- Hat
- Bible
- Cell phone and charger
- Extra spending money (money for two meals)
- Medications if needed (If you are a minor and take any medications, please inform Mrs. Jana Jaroszewski.)
- Reusable water bottle

- Displaying Christian maturity with a willingness to learn.
- Willingness to be flexible and adaptable.
- Willingness to attend mandatory mission trip orientation and spiritual preparation sessions. Date and time TBA
- Patient ability to work with children, some of whom have special needs.
- Good team player.
- Willingness to commit 8 hours a day solely to the needs of children.
